

Background - Project at IIPA

Suitable knowledge and skills are required for district officials to successfully implement the prestigious Digital India Program that had been announced by Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India (GoI) in the year 2015. MeitY has therefore entrusted IIPA with a partial component on human resource capacity building that seeks to augment the knowledge and skills of district officials using Training of Trainer (ToT) pedagogy, with some identified ATIs. The e-trainers/ experts drawn from these identified ATIs are trained at IIPA, who further, train the district officials mostly from weaker sections in their respective states (Figure -1). The main aim of this project at IIPA is to enhance the awareness of e-governance under Digital India programme for district officials, especially SC/ST officers/ and/or officers employed in predominant SC/ST areas, by strengthening capacities of state administrative training institutes-ATIs, using Training of Trainers (ToT) pedagogy.

To accomplish this project vision, IIPA is expected to train the nominated resource persons, (henceforth referred to as only 'ATI trainers'), as per the prescribed ToT methodology using a centrally designed content on e-governance, Digital India and its latest initiatives. The proposed five-day Training-of-Trainers (ToT) programme, titled as 'Training of Trainers (ToT) on 'Digital India and its Latest Initiatives, is the seventh one, in the sequence of conduct of ToTs at IIPA.

Aim and Objectives

The proposed ToT aims to empower the ATI trainers with training tools and techniques so that they may deliver effective training on e-Governance, Digital India and its latest initiatives to the district officials in their states. It strives to empower the ATI trainers with knowledge and skills required to deliver effective training on relevant topics including Basics of Digital India & its key initiatives, and emerging technologies (AI, IoT, BlockChain), with special reference to cyber security aspects as well as learnings from the best practices at both state and centre level.

Programme Objectives

By the end of this ToT programme, the ATI trainers will be able to:

- Enumerate the details of Digital India and its latest initiatives
- Appreciate technology based public service delivery initiatives of Delhi state
- Understand the concept of Digital Safety- both at the organizational level as well as individual level
- List the applications of Emerging Technologies (AI, IoT, BlockChain)
- Describe important aspects of Government e-Marketplace(GeM)
- Learn from the national level award winning initiatives such as UMANG, Hello Doctor and National Government Network (NGN)
- Describe the relevance and importance of Smart Villages
- Impart training on how to use Digital Payment methods
- List Basic Terminology Associated with Training.
- Impart training on Digital India to the district officials as per the centralized content.

Course Design

The course strives to align its participants to advance knowledge of e-governance and Digital India, as well as to impart training skills to them in the same domain. Therefore, the proposed ToT course has two broad components of Knowledge (referred as '*Content*') and Skills (referred as '*Training techniques*') amalgamated with each other, each of which are detailed herewith –

Component-1: Content

It is the knowledge component of the training that aims to deliver the understanding of basic facts and details related to e-governance, Digital India and its latest initiative. It is this content that these ATI trainers would eventually deliver to the district officials of their respective States.

Component 2- Training Techniques

This is the skill related component of the proposed ToT in which the ATI trainers would acquire several training techniques that would enhance their existing training delivery abilities in delivering the content of component-1 to the target group of district officials to be trained by them. They would be able to choose specific training methods as per the objectives of the training content and as per the nature and abilities of their target group of district officials. Further they would also be able to deliver the proposed content to them in a more effective and systematic manner.

Invited Delegates: Officers from the identified ATIs, MeitY officials, selected e-Gov trainers, select invitees from academia and industry, IIPA team

Methodology: Experiential Presentations, Practical Sessions, Brainstorming, Open House Discussions and Class room sessions.
