ABOUT CLIMATE SMART GOVERNANCE

IIPA is working on project entitled “Climate Smart Governance” sponsored by DST in collaboration with SEEDS. Project duration is of 3 years. The major objective of this project is to conduct three Capacity Building Programs per year, targeting different groups and sensitizing them on different aspects of **climate smart governance**.

The broad themes will cover **Climate Change Adaptation**, underpinning the sectoral impacts on Water Resources including Glaciers, Agriculture, Human Health, Social-Economic Vulnerability and Livelihood, Extreme events, disaster risk reduction and management. The other theme would be **Climate Change Mitigation** entailing Renewable Energy Options, energy Efficiency, Sustainable habitat.

OBJECTIVES

- Understand the basic science behind Climate Change
- Comprehend the sectoral Climate Change affects
- Explain the projections of Climate Change and its links
- Develop and carry out sectoral impacts, vulnerability and adaptive capacity assessment in relation to Climate Change
- Translate results of the assessment into adaptation needs and options
- Develop Climate Change and adaptation strategy and national/ sub-national health action plans
- Engage stakeholders and other sectors
- Recognize, promote and integrate co-benefits of mitigation measures in other sectors

Fees
