IIPA is working on project entitled "Climate Smart Governance" sponsored by DST in collaboration with SEEDS Technical Services Pvt. Ltd. Project duration is of 3 years. The major objective of this project is to conduct three Capacity Building Programs per year, targeting different groups and sensitizing them on different aspects of **climate smart governance**.

The broad themes will cover **Climate Change Adaptation**, underpinning the sectoral impacts on Water Resources including Glaciers, Agriculture, Human Health, Social-Economic Vulnerability and Livelihood, Extreme events, disaster risk reduction and management.
