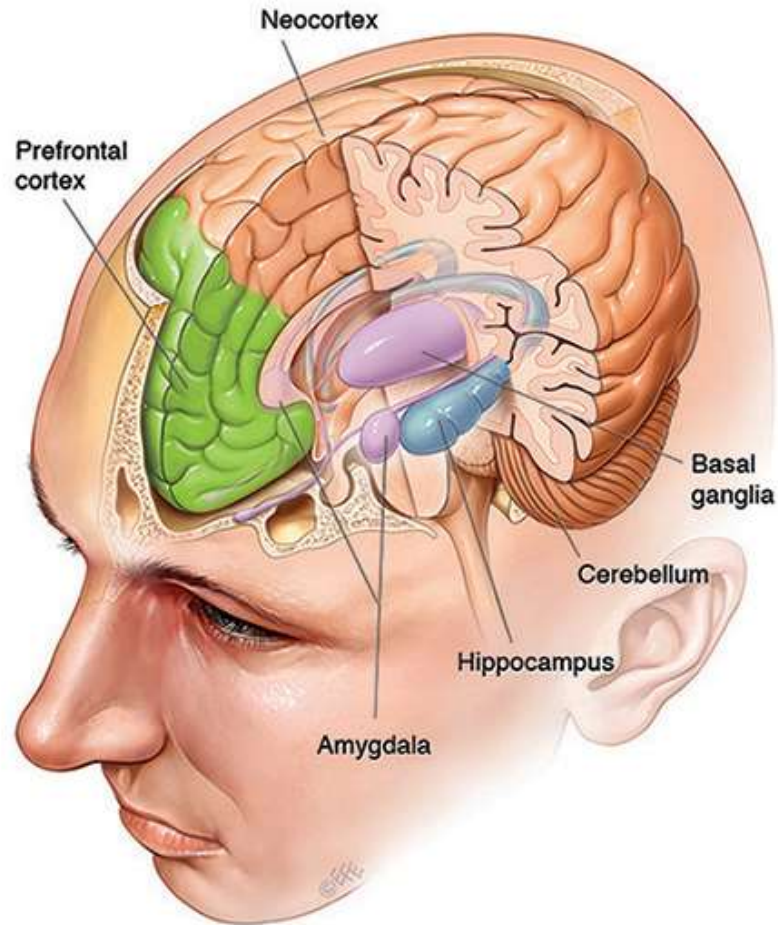
Conceptual Thinking and Citizen centric governance – Why
