The De-notified Tribes, Nomadic Tribes, and Semi-Nomadic Tribes are contemporary India's one of the most marginalized and vulnerable social groups. These conditions are exacerbated by the historical injustices as ingrained upon these communities. On the historical count, the injustice was sanctioned and multiplied through the promulgation of legal act i.e. Criminal Tribes Act 1871 by the British Raj, branding the members of these communities as Criminals. The act entrenched social stigmatization and labelling of communities as criminals in the society with ascription of dishonoured titles on the community members which persist in various forms till today causing extreme discrimination rendering the group as more vulnerable and mandating requirement of specialised attention through focused research, deliberations, dialogues, and policy interventions.
