The convocation ceremony for the participants of the 50th Advanced Professional Programme on Public Administration (APPPA) was organized on April 30, 2025 at TNC Memorial Hall of IIPA. Hon'ble Union Minister and Chairman of IIPA Dr Jitendra Singh was the chief guest for the event. In a candid and wide-ranging address, the Hon'ble Minister emphasized the need for continuous learning and adaptive policy- making in the face of exponential technological advancements. "We could very well see participants of the 50th APPPA returning for



refresher courses by the 55th," he quipped, stressing the need to keep administrative knowledge up to date. Lauding IIPA's initiative to organize APPPA's golden jubilee programme, he underscored the importance of civil-military synergy. "Today's army officers don't just stay in isolation; they are expected to brief the media, interact with civilians and respond jointly in disaster-affected regions," he noted, calling for greater focus on communication skills in future iterations of the course.



Prof Neetu Jain was the Programme Director and Dr Saket Bihari was the Programme Co-Director of the 50th APPPA. During the occasion, the Hon'ble Union Minister along with Ms Chhavi Bhardwaj, IAS, Joint Secretary, DoPT conferred the degree of Master of Arts in Public Policy and Public Administration of Panjab University and Diploma in Public Administration to participants of 49th and 50th APPPA respectively.
