













Research


Research is a creative and systematic work undertaken to increase the stock of knowledge. It involves the collection, organization and analysis of evidences to increase understanding of a topic, characterized by a particular attentiveness to controlling sources of bias and error. These activities are characterized by accounting and controlling for biases. A research project may be an expansion on past work in the field. To test the validity of instruments, procedures, or experiments, research may replicate elements of prior projects or the project.

The primary purposes of basic research are documentation, discovery, interpretation, and the research and development of methods and systems for the advancement of human knowledge. Approaches to research depend on epistemologies, which vary considerably both within and between humanities and sciences. The faculty is employed under Specialized Centres for conducting the research. The studies carried out in the beginning years were from a very small domain. The canvass covered by the Institute's research studies is much wider and includes inquiry pertained to the Public Administration, Delegation of Administrative Authority, Financial Controls, Environmental and Issues of Climate Change, Sustainable Development, Disaster Management, Public Service Delivery, Big Data Analysis, Cyber Security, E-governance, Urban Management and the like.




IIPA is imparting training and capacity building to the government officials of India and abroad since 1959. Every year, IIPA conducts more than 100 training programmes for the officials. The flagship programme of IIPA is 10-month Advanced Professional Programme in Public Administration (APPPA) which is attended by senior officials of All India Services (AIS), Provincial Civil Service-Judicial (PCS-J), Central Civil Services and Defense Services mainly Indian Administrative Services (IAS), Indian Police Services (IPS), Indian Revenue Services (IRS), Indian Air Force, Indian Army and various other services. IIPA conducts training for the officials of different departments and ministries of Government of India and State Governments on various topics of Governance, Finance, Communication, Leadership, Administration, Environment, Sustainable Development, Climate Change and Management. The period of training programme varies from 3 days to 10 months. IIPA is also involved in the capacity building of the civil servants of foreign countries and has conducted training for the officials of Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Maldives, Nepal, Vietnam, Mongolia, African and Latin American countries under direct and ITEC programme.





Dr. Ambedkar Centre for Social Justice



Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Chair in Social Justice was set up at the Indian Institute of Public Administration in 2004 by Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Foundation, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India. Since its inception, it has been the consistent endeavor of the Chair to work on the given theme i.e. 'Social Justice' focusing on the issues concerning exclusion, inclusion, marginalization, disadvantaged sections etc. As per the mandate of the Chair, number of quality publications, value adding workshops, memorial lectures, national seminars, dialogues/discussion, awareness and extension programmes, inter-chaircollaborating programmes are organized regularly. The events center around Dr. B. R. Ambedkar's work and philosophy, issues relating to socio- economic and cultural life of scheduled castes, scheduled tribes, minorities, backward classes and other weaker sections of the society. This chair has a special significance being at an institute – a premier National Institute of Public Governance, which has key role in providing inputs for policy formulation and governance besides sensitizing the Administration.



Environment, Climate Change Et Drought Administration



The centre was established in 1992 and rechristened as the Center for Climate Change, Environment and Drought Administration in 2010. The Centre undertakes, organizes and facilitates faculty development programmes, conferences, capacity building programmes, seminars, exposure visits and research in sectoral issues of Environment, Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction. These instruments help in honing the skills of the Policy Makers, Academia, Researchers and the like to equip them with the latest dynamics of the Climate Change. The nuances are brainstormed in the training session which arms the Government machinery to tread towards Good Governance.



Centre for Consumer Studies



In view of the emerging global markets and concerns for good governance coupled with rising expectations of the people for better services, quality goods, availability of choice and value for money, there is universal emphasis for protection and promotion of Consumers' rights and interests. It is well recognized, world over, that protection of Consumers' rights and interests not only promotes the interests of business but also of the state as well. To give boost to the efforts of the Government in the area of consumer protection and consumer welfare the need of a dedicated centre was identified. The Centre has emerged as a "Centre for Excellence" through its various activities. This is the only centre of its kind in the country dedicated exclusively for protection and promotion of consumers' right to education."



Centre for Economic Growth Et Management Studies



The activities of the Centre are organized in three inter-related areas of research including advisory services, training and publication including dissemination of knowledge. The centre undertakes sponsored research studies generally from governments at Union, State and Local level, Constitutional Bodies and multi lateral & bi-lateral organizations on contemporary economic issues of public concern. It also conducts research on its own to find solutions in difficult decision-making areas. The Centre offers advisory services in areas of public economics and provides the necessary hand-holding in implementation of schemes, programmes and projects in both Government and private sectors. It conducts a large number of long and short-duration training programmes.



Centre for Economic Growth Et Management Studies



A Committee on case study was set up on March 25, 1961 with a objective and directive to set up a Case Study Programme on a pilot scale. The objective of IPRA's Case Study Programme is to build a body of knowledge in governance through case studies with a view to promote deeper and wider understanding of the functioning of Indian Administration in its specific environmental and institutional framework and also to broaden our knowledge and understanding of global and national best practices. In order to develop relevant case studies for use in the learning process, IPRA has renamed its annual case study competition as the Annual Decision Making/Teaching Case Study Competition.



Centre for Good Governance



The Centre was established on July 2019 and the mandate of the Centre is to work for the automation/administration of the office, e-office, IT related activities, IIPA publications and activities of the computer centre. The Centre is involved in the implementation of e-office programme in IIPA and process management in this regard. The e-office programme is implemented in all the sections of the institute and the work process with files, noting, enclosures etc. are fully automated and paperless. The Centre is also working for the development of the standards and quality of the publications of IIPA. National Knowledge Network (NKN) is established with speed of 100 mbps. The Centre was instrumental in the establishment of seven VC and Digital Classrooms for online training by faculty of IIPA during the COVID-19 pandemic and subscription to CISCO Webex platform for online interactive lectures. IIPA launched its new web-portal which is more comprehensive, dynamic and has interactive features.



Centre of Tribal Research Et Exploration



IPRA has been entrusted with the task to strengthen training and active research in various aspects of tribal welfare, by Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA), Government of India. For this purpose, a Centre of Excellence has been established at IPRA and is named as the Centre of Tribal Research and Exploration (COTREX). Since its inception, it has been the consistent endeavour of COTREX to work on Tribal Research and Exploration focusing on the issues concerning exclusion, inclusion, marginalization, etc. of the tribal communities. As per the mandate of the MoTA and COTREX, quality publications, value adding workshops, memorial lectures, national seminars, dialogue/ discussion, awareness and extension programmes, inter-COTREX collaborating programmes are to be organized regularly. This Centre has key role in providing inputs for policy formulation and governance besides sensitizing the Administration.



Centre for Urban Studies



Centre for Urban Studies (CUS) initially known as Centre for Training and Research in Municipal Administration (CTRMA), later renamed as CUS in 1974-75, was established in IIPA in 1966 with the support from Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Planning the then nodal ministry on urban local bodies/governments as a result of recommendations from Nuruddin Committee Report, 1963. It was duly endorsed by RURC (Rural Urban Relationship Committee) in 1966. Initially Centre was guided by a senior level advisory committee having the then minister for Parliamentary Affairs Shri I.K. Gujral and Mr. Nuruddin Ahmad, the then Mayor of Delhi as members and representatives from Ministries of Health & Family Welfare, Petroleum, Planning Commission etc. Subsequently, the advisory committee was replaced by a Steering Committee having representation from Ministry of Works & Housing/Urban Development and now Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, regional urban centres and select state governments. As a part of IIPA CUS since beginning has developed and strengthened its national and inter country outpath and coverage of stakeholders. Director IIPA is director CUS and chairperson of steering committee and Coordinator CUS is the member secretary of Steering committee.



Centre for International Relations



International Relations comprises of a gamut of themes and intertwined contours where-in, the entire gamut of Global happenings with an India centric vision happens to be the order of the day for the Centre at the prestigious premise of IIPA. India happens to be the navae nerve centre of International happenstance and development along with the Oriental and Asiatic Pivot of Global geo-politics and geo-economics. The notion of , "With Great Power comes great responsibility" happens to be the clarion call for New Delhi, where-in, the larger idios of strategic autonomy, fruitful bilateral trysts in the neighbourhood and the intent to resist the traditional and quintessential regional antagonists amidst a cesspool of dynamic International system is the Global calling. The Indian partnership bordering on to pragmatic and symbiotic trysts with the Great Powers such as United States, Soviet Union and China too have been earmarked as the key partnerships to be analysed and zeroed in by the IIPA's centre. The course enables the experienced senior bureaucrats who are working in a range of national and International policy arenas to develop their policy analyses. The exceptional feature of combining an advanced capacity development programme with the thesis based on an original topic makes it unique and distinct from other courses.



Campus Et Facilities

Institute is situated in the campus spread over six acre plot on the Ring Road in Indraprastha Estate, New Delhi established in 1959.
