Hon'ble Union Minister Dr Jitendra Singh addresses officers of Indian Statistical Service

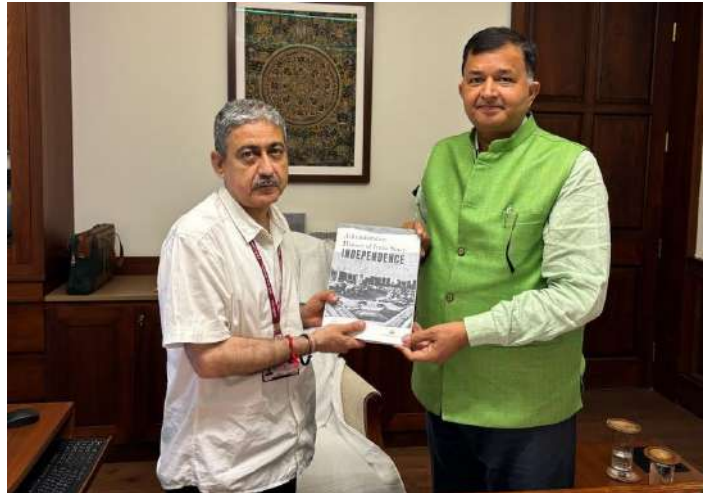

❖ DG IIPA Shri SN Tripathi presented a copy of IIPA publication to Sri Rajit Punhani, IAS on June 21, 2024.

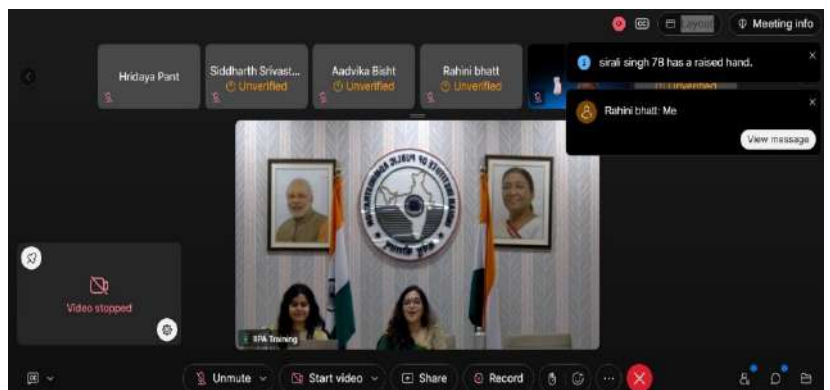
