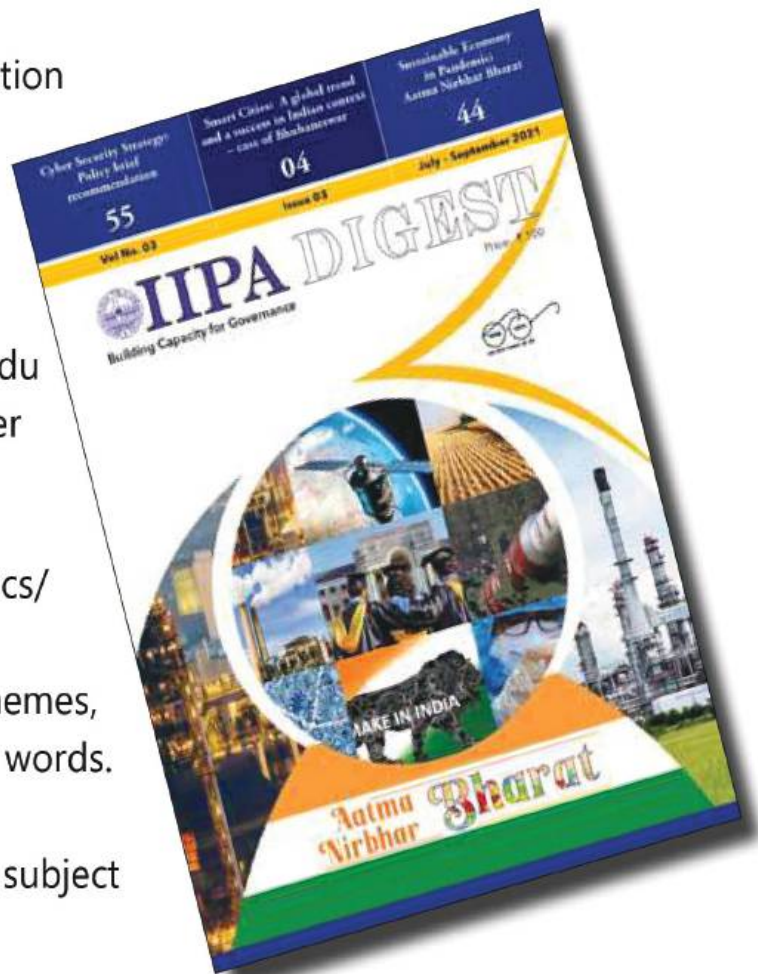
IIPA DIGEST: INVITE FOR CONTRIBUTIONS
