Hon'ble Vice President of India and President of IIPA, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar, Hon'ble Union Minister and Chairman of IIPA EC, Dr Jitendra Singh along with many dignitaries like Shri Shekhar Dutt, Former Governor of Chhatisgarh, Dr. Harsh Vardhan, Former Union Minister and Senior Officers graced the occasion.

Upon his arrival, the Vice President of India paid floral tributes to the bust of the Mahatma Gandhi and Sardar Patel at IIPA premises. Director General of IIPA, Shri SN Tripathi presented the welcome remarks. While delivering the inaugural memorial lecture on *Governance: Separation of Powers*, the Vice President said, “As the President of

this Institute of national repute, I acknowledge and appreciate that IIPA brings administration and scholarship together.” He emphasized that governance is a dynamic concept and public administrators has to remain in tune with the changing expectations and requirements of citizens. The next 25 years are going to be crucial for the country. The civil servants who are joining today, will be



the 'Warriors of 2047'. Today, India is on rise, inspired by the surge of aspirations and innovations and validated by the achievements of our citizens, he added. He also highlighted various Citizen-centric welfare schemes of the Govt. of India of recent times. Speaking on 'Governance: Separation of Powers', he outlined the nature of 'Delicate equilibrium'



amongst the three organs of the State and emphasized that this must be maintained. Hon'ble Union Minister and Chairman of EC IIPA, Dr Jitender Singh also spoke during the occasion. In his address, Dr Jitendra Singh said that the Union Government is driven by the concept of “Whole of Government” approach in matters of public administration. Soon after Shri Narendra Modi took over as Prime Minister, one of the earliest mantras that he gave us was “Maximum Governance, Minimum Government”, he added. The Hon'ble Union Minister noted with satisfaction that the IIPA courses have undergone changes and new areas like Atmanirbhar Bharat and Mission Karmayogi apart from other important government initiatives have been covered. He said, “This makes the course more relevant and useful and it has given a good exposure to rural and urban development schemes. It has helped the officers in better understanding and appreciation of various socio-economic schemes”. The coffee table book of IIPA by faculty Dr Shyamli Singh and a book on Bharat Ratna: Inspiring Works of Rajendra Prasad by Shri SN Tripathi and Dr Saket Bihari were also released during the event. The event was compered and coordinated by Shri Amitabh Ranjan, Registrar, IIPA. Besides participants of the 48th APPPA, other trainees of the ongoing programmes along with the faculty and senior administrative officers and staff of IIPA attended the event.

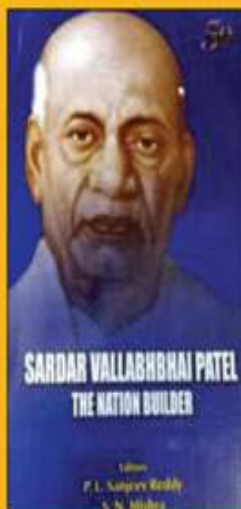
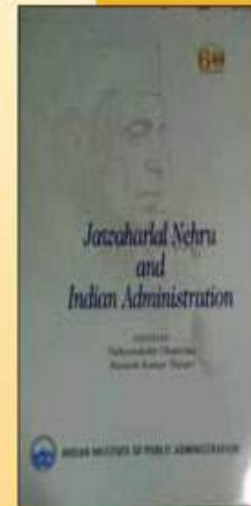
