The Executive Council approved several agenda items, including confirmation of the previous meeting's minutes, adoption of the Annual Report and audited accounts for 2024-25, admission of new life members, and establishment of a new local branch at Nanded, Maharashtra. administration can support the creation of an inclusive and future-ready workforce. The conference was themed on Empowering Tomorrow: AI, Skills and Global Competence.


