The North-East and Hill state branches may be given some relaxation in the target. More members who are serving and from administrative services, academics and professionals may be included. For this purpose, IIPA will provide financial assistance of Rs.25,000/- to any Branch which takes up and complete the documentation of the district in its area. A budget provision of Rs.5 lakh for this purpose will be made by IIPA.

DG, IIPA said that the district in this regard will be the districts from 1947 period will be taken into consideration. Chairman, EC said that there is need of more examination in this matter. From 1947 to till date, there are several changes in the state and district level. Many new states are created, and many new districts are formed. One district from the period of 1947 has been divided into many other districts and so forth. Different connotations are there in this regard. There will be issues regarding resources, structure, system, governance models etc. and comparison may not be even. This is very rigorous exercise and parameters need to be established. The Chairman suggested that NITI Aayog has come up with some parameters for aspirational districts which may be examined also to evolve parameters for this study.

Dr. Arun Kumar Rath, Chairman, Odisha Regional Branch said that it is very good idea for the documentation, but parameters need to be developed first. We will do it in one district of Odisha State.

Shri S.S. Kshatriya, Chairman, Maharashtra Regional Branch said that he supports this programme and initiative. He suggested that tribal areas and areas which are mostly left out since independence may be taken into for studies. We will take up one district in State of Maharashtra.

DG, IIPA said that the suggestions of the Chairman, EC will be taken into consideration. A more detailed proposal will be made with defined parameters and the Branches will be asked to submit proposals in this regard.

<p>(i) Infrastructure Development works in IIPA.</p> <p>Director General, IIPA informed the EC about the infrastructure development works at IIPA. IIPA developed eight state of art lecture halls after covid including T N Chaturvedi Memorial Hall with 200 capacity, meeting halls Samiksha I & II, Samridhi (for APPPA) and Sambhav which has been inaugurated by the Hon'ble Minister and Chairman, EC during this EC meeting. Two floors of IIPA new building are nearing completion which may be used for expansion of IIPA. Four more floors will be constructed and contract in this regard has been given to M/s TCIL, a 100% Central Government Company under Deptt. of Telecom.</p> <p>Director General, IIPA updated about the Civil Services Mentoring Programme of IIPA. Chairman, EC suggested that the name 'Civil Services' needed to be re-looked and it needed to be changed as it may arise conflict in many senses. A different name including the words competitive examination etc. may be thought off. Item No.322.10 MoU with Print Publications Pvt Ltd. for Lok Prashasan and Nagarlok.

IIPA has entered into an agreement with M/s SAGE for publishing and marketing its flagship journal, IIPA six years back as IIPA does not have a marketing unit and it is very hard for IIPA to market and sell its publications. This has paid handsome dividend as IIPA has been receiving good royalty (Around Rs.7.00 Lakh in 2022-23) as well as IIPA has reached many English-speaking countries across the Globe.

With a view to increase the visibility of rest of its journals - namely Lok Prashasan (a quarterly Hindi journal on Public Administration) and Nagarlok (a quarterly English journal on Urban Affairs), IIPA had sought partnership proposals from several publishers based in Delhi-NCR. Renowned publishers including Sage and Taylor & Francis along with other publishing houses were approached for partnership proposals. Sage shared a publishing proposal of Rs 13 lacs + GST annually for collaborating for Lok Prashasan. Due to the high rates proposed by other publishers, IIPA could only shortlist the proposal of Print Publications Pvt Ltd (PPPL) with the following salient points:

- a. IIPA will retain its complete copyright.
- b. PPPL will be entrusted with the management of the publication of journal – Lok Prashasan and Nagarlok for a period of 5 Years starting with Volume 15 (2023) & Volume 55 (2023) respectively.
- c. Free online access to Life Members of IIPA.
- d. 220 pages per issue with a maximum of 900 pages per volume will be the limit.
- e. Since we are now going for 04 issues for Lok Prashasan also, the subvention amount would be Rs.1.60 lakh per annum for Lok Prashasan and Nagarlok each.
- f. PPPL will pay an annual Royalty of 10% on the net sale proceeds.



(b) MoU between IIPA and Panjab University

The eligible participants of APPPA course used to get M.Phil. degree from Panjab University on successful completion of the 10 month long Advanced Professional Programme in Public Administration (APPPA), one of the oldest Mid-career Capacity Building Programmes of DoPT, designed for Mid-Senior Civil Servants and Defence Forces Officers. This arrangement started in 1983 and has continued till the just concluded 48th APPPA Course.

However, as per the National Education Policy 2020, the M.Phil. degree has been discontinued now. But the Panjab University has kindly agreed to continue the long term collaboration between IIPA and Panjab University. IIPA and Panjab University has entered into an MoU on 8th May, 2023 wherein the participants of APPPA course, starting from the ensuring 49th APPPA will get the Degree of 'Executive Masters in Public Administration and Public Policy' (EMPPP) on successful completion of the Course.

The advantage of this Degree is that, earlier only participants having a PG degree with 50% marks were eligible for the M.Phil. degree. However, now all participants successfully completing APPPA will be eligible for EMPPP as minimum qualification for it, is Graduation only.

The Executive Council considered the proposal and approved that the District level documentation in States from expansion of original district from Gazetteer period be done by IIPA Regional and Local Branches in one district of a State by one branch in their respective areas. The documentation will cover the original district from 1947 to its present status,

evolution of the district and change in its structure, changing role and dynamics of Public Administration there etc.

For this purpose, IIPA will provide financial assistance of Rs.25,000/- to any Branch which takes up and complete the documentation of the district in its area. A budget provision of Rs.5 lakh for this purpose will be made by IIPA.

DG, IIPA said that the district in this regard will be the districts from 1947 period will be taken into consideration. Chairman, EC said that there is need of more examination in this matter. From 1947 to till date, there are several changes in the state and district level. Many new states are created, and many new districts are formed. One district from the period of 1947 has been divided into many other districts and so forth. Different connotations are there in this regard. There will be issues regarding resources, structure, system, governance models etc. and comparison may not be even. This is very rigorous exercise and parameters need to be established. The Chairman suggested that NITI Aayog has come up with some parameters for aspirational districts which may be examined also to evolve parameters for this study.

Dr. Arun Kumar Rath, Chairman, Odisha Regional Branch said that it is very good idea for the documentation, but parameters need to be developed first. We will do it in one district of Odisha State.

Shri S.S. Kshatriya, Chairman, Maharashtra Regional Branch said that he supports this programme and initiative. He suggested that tribal areas and areas which are mostly left out since independence may be taken into for studies. We will take up one district in State of Maharashtra.

DG, IIPA said that the suggestions of the Chairman, EC will be taken into consideration. A more detailed proposal will be made with defined parameters and the Branches will be asked to submit proposals in this regard.
