IIPA is doing well and it has reached District and Local Government level but there is need to have more visibility which will be possible if private sector is also included. The outreach of IIPA needs to be expanded to the private sector. Shri Sriram Taranikanti, IAS, Director LBSNAA, Mussoorie said that many private organizations and institutions are conducting training sessions for the government officials. There are various topics such as Human Values and Ethics where there is need for more training and capacity building. IIPA may explore these areas.

Director General IIPA informed that IIPA is trying to get participants of the private sector and IIPA already conducted training for the Tata Group, Maruti Udyog officials and there is an Advanced Leadership Programme (ALP) which is meant for the senior executives of the PSUs and IIPA can try to attract participants from private sector in this ALP programme. Registrar, IIPA informed that IIPA has collaborated with Amazon for conducting training programmes/workshops on consumer issues.

IIPA has collaborated with National Academy of Human Resource Development (NAHRD) and conducted Training Programmes on Cyber Security and other themes for Public Sector and Scientific Institutions where Officers from BIRAC and ANRF along with from many Banks also participated. IIPA organized a one day Conference on Digital Transformation and allied topics for Corporate and Private Sector Officials along with Banks like HDFC, ICICI, Axis, SBI, BoB etc. sponsored by AWS.

IIPA is in discussion with HCL Tech also for collaboration in Capacity Building field.
