MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
HO CHI MINH NATIONAL ACADEMY OF
POLITICS
SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM
AND
INDIAN INSTITUTE OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION
NEW DELHI

Ho Chi Minh National Academy of Politics (hereafter referred to as “HCMA”) and Indian Institute of Public Administration (hereafter referred to as “IIPA”) (hereinafter referred to as “two Parties”) on a voluntary and mutually beneficial basis, cooperate and exchange bilaterally in the field of scientific research, training and fostering of staff members, lecturers and students of both sides.

The two Parties agree to sign the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) in according with the following terms:

Article 1: Objectives

- To contribute to the enhancement of relationships between Socialist Republic of Vietnam and Republic of India;
- To strengthen cooperation between the two Parties in areas where both sides have strengths, especially on the field of public administration and scientific research;
- To improve the quality of leadership and managerial capacity of key senior and middle ranking officials.

Article 2: Scope of cooperation

- Joint hold research scientific activities such as: study scientific thesis, organize scientific workshops, seminars, and conferences on topics of common interests.
- Exchange faculty members, officials and experts between the two institutions periodically.
- Collaborate in organizing short-term training courses for staff members of HCMA.
- Exchange and share information resources such as journals, books, and other forms of publication between the two Parties.
- Make efforts by the two Parties to find and carry out specific programs or projects for mutual collaboration for which funds are raised by the two Parties, or funded by international organizations.

Article 3: Dispute resolution

Any possible disputes between the two Parties relating to the interpretation and/or implementation of the MOU shall be resolved in a peaceful manner under the consultation and/or negotiation of the two Parties.

Article 4: Implementation

To implement the scope of cooperation as stated in Article 2, the two Parties will negotiate to establish a specific cooperation program to achieve the objectives as stated in Article 1.

At the Ho Chi Minh National Academy of Politics, the President of HCMA authorizes the Director Centre for Indian Studies to concretize the agreement through this MOU. The contact points and coordinators of the Parties are:

Article 5: Validity and Termination

- This MOU shall become effective upon its signature by the competent persons of the two Parties and shall be valid for three years. This MOU may also be extended or modified under agreement in writing of the two Parties. - Either Party may terminate this MOU upon six (06) month's written notice to the other. If this MOU is terminated by either Party, neither Party will suffer from any loss of money and any other possible loss.



- Termination of the MOU does not affect the completion of activities initiated by the two parties before the time of termination of the MOU, unless otherwise agreed by the two parties.
- This MOU is non-exclusive. The parties have the freedom to engage in agreements with other parties including cooperation on issues within the scope of this memorandum.
- Both Parties acknowledge that the financial allocations for each activity will have to be negotiated and depend on the availability of funds.


This MOU is signed virtually on the 12th Day of November, 2024 and made into two equally authentic originals.
