Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called the "MoU") is entered into on Ninth day of April 2025, between:

Indian Academy of Highway Engineers (IAHE), an apex training institute imparts training to Road/Highway Professionals which is under the administrative control of the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India, located at A-5 NH-24 Bypass, Institutional Area, Sector 62, Noida, Uttar Pradesh 201309, represented by the **Director IAHE**, hereinafter referred to as "**IAHE**",

And

Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), New Delhi, an autonomous institute under the Department of Personnel and Training, Government of India, to equip the public servants with domain knowledge, functional skills, and behavioural competencies required for managing the task of governance located at IP Estate, Ring Road, ITO New Delhi 110002, represented by the **Director General** hereinafter referred to as "**IIPA**".

The above two organizations hereinafter jointly referred to as "the Parties"

NOW THEREFORE the parties have reached the following MoU:

Article 1


Objective:

The objective of this MoU is to establish a cooperative institutional relation to encourage the advancement of education, research, and training, fostering innovative training, and promoting collaboration to promote public infrastructure and enhance the skills and capacity building of Highway professionals and civil servants.

Article 2

Area of Co-operation & Scope:

The Parties herein will support to each other endeavors by collaborating on education/training/research to meet the evolving needs for Safe, Sustainable & Efficient development of Public Infrastructure in India.



Collaboration for all related activities which include:

- (i) Capacity Building and Training Programme
- (ii) Joint Research Studies
- (iii) Faculty exchange
- (iv) Joint Programme apart from training such as Workshops/Seminars/Conferences
- (v) Sharing of facilities of both the institutions
- (vi) Organizing Study Visits in each other institutions for their training participants

Article 3

Implementation and Roles & Responsibilities:

Implementation:

The collaboration between the parties may include, but is not limited to, the following activities:

- a) The Parties shall hold periodical consultations between themselves as deemed necessary for implementing this MoU.
- b) Specific details of procedures and programmes for exchange and co-operative activities will be decided through mutual consent
- c) Conduction of various mutually planned & agreed training programs for Highway Professionals/Civil Servants. These programs may be conducted either at the IAHE campus Noida or at IIPA campus New Delhi.
- d) There will be an exchange of faculty members and Subject Matter Experts between both parties to effectively achieve the mission of this MoU.
- e) There will be a sharing of infrastructure required for training between both institutes making this collaboration impactful.
- f) Both institutes may participate in/organize various conferences, symposiums, and other academic events to showcase collaborative efforts and disseminate knowledge.
- g) Both institutes may carryout joint research studies on various issues about public policy issues, public infrastructure like highways and their social and economic impact, challenges in the implementation of projects, etc.

The aforementioned implementation areas are just intended to exemplify both institutions and add other areas in case of need with due discussions with each other to enhance the impact of this collaboration at the National and International level.



Roles & Responsibilities of IAHE & IIPA:

- a) The nomination of participants, timing, duration, etc. of training programs will be determined through mutual consultation between both institutes.
- b) If the training program takes place at the IAHE's Noida campus, IAHE will provide all necessary training infrastructures for IIPA faculty members and participants.
- c) If the training program is held at the IIPA campus in New Delhi, IIPA will provide all required training infrastructure, IAHE faculty members, and participants.
- d) Both Parties will exchange detailed course content, and educational resources, including learning materials, and curricula.
- e) Any financial implication arising out of the exchange of faculty or facilities in each party's premises shall be decided by mutual consent and agreement of both parties.
- f) Both institutions will adhere to all relevant laws, regulations, and institutional policies governing collaborative activities.

Article 4

Validity of MoU:

This MoU shall come into effect on the date of its signing by both institutes and shall remain in force for 05 years unless terminated earlier by mutual agreement. Upon expiration, the MoU may be renewed by mutual consent of both institutes.

Article 5


Amendment:

Any amendment or modification to this MoU shall be made in writing and duly signed by authorized representatives of both parties by mutual consent during the validity of this MoU. Any difference arising out of the interpretation, implementation, or application of the MoU shall be resolved amicably through consultation between the Parties, represented by the respective Competent Authorities.

Article 6

Termination

Either party may terminate this MoU by providing a written notice to the other party at least 60 days before the intended date of termination. Termination of this MoU shall not affect any ongoing collaborative training programs or commitments unless otherwise agreed upon by both institutes.







Article 7
