PARTNERSHIP AND COLLABORATIVE ENGAGEMENT**

BETWEEN

Shri Krishna Institute of Public Administration (SKIPA), an institution under the Government of Jharkhand, having its main office at Meurs Road, Ranchi-834001, Jharkhand (hereinafter referred to as "SKIPA," which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, mean and include its successors and permitted assigns), of the Second Part.

AND

The Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), New Delhi was created in 29th March 1954 under the Societies Act of 1860. It has its main office at The Indian Institute of Public Administration, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as "Indian Institute of Public Administration, New Delhi" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, mean and include its successors and permitted assigns), of the First Party;

Hereinafter, Indian Institute of Public Administration, New Delhi and Shri Krishna Institute of Public Administration (SKIPA), Ranchi, Jharkhand shall collectively be referred to as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), New Delhi is a leading institution for Training, Research, Advisory and consultancy services, Information, dissemination and exchange. It is committed to enhance leadership managerial and administrative capabilities of executives in Government and Public sector enterprises.


AND WHEREAS, Shri Krishna Institute of Public Administration (SKIPA), Ranchi, Jharkhand is a premier institute dedicated to the capacity building for government officials through training, research, advisory and consultancy services;

AND WHEREAS, the Parties wish to collaborate in areas of mutual interest to enhance knowledge sharing, best practices, build capacity, and jointly promote research and development in the area of academics and capacity building of public servants undergoing training at both institutes.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to recognize the need to share value of academics co-operation and having agreed to further continue their common interests in promoting the mutual cooperation in the area of academics and capacity building of public servants.

AND WHEREAS it is also necessary to collaborate in the academics and capacity building in which grains for both the institutes shall be several and equal without any financial liability on either of the institutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and undertakings set forth herein, the Parties agree as follows:



1. OBJECTIVES AND SCOPE

1.1 Objectives:

This Agreement aims to establish a collaborative framework to:

- Enhance knowledge-sharing through training programs, research, and capacity-building initiatives for Public servants.
- Develop innovative solutions and approaches to address governance, public administration, and technological challenges.

1.2 Scope of Collaboration:-

The collaboration shall include, but is not limited to:

- **Training Programs:** Design and delivery of training sessions tailored to the needs of SKIPA's target audience.
- **Joint Research:** Undertaking research projects in areas of mutual interest, including policy advocacy and advisory services.
- **Capacity Building:** Development of customized training materials, field visits, and workshops.
- **Consulting Assignments:** Collaborative consulting on technological and policy-driven initiatives for public and private sector stakeholders.
- **Faculty Exchange:** - Share expert knowledge between both institutions.


2. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

2.1 Responsibilities of SKIPA, Ranchi:

- Identify and communicate training needs and topics to Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), New Delhi for exchange of knowledge and capacity building.
- Provide logistical support, including access to state government officials and offices.
- Facilitate best practice tours and field visits within Jharkhand.
- Maintain and share records of participant feedback and training outcomes.
- Convene quarterly review meetings to monitor the progress of joint initiatives.

2.2 Responsibilities of Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), New Delhi:

- Develop and deliver training programs, including course content and materials.
- Provide faculty or experts for training delivery and consulting assignments.
- Customize training and research materials to reflect local and contextual needs.
- Participate in quarterly review meetings to assess progress and alignment with objectives.



2.3 Joint Responsibilities:

- Appoint Single Points of Contact (SPOCs) to coordinate activities under this Agreement.
- Share access to libraries, infrastructure, and resources for collaborative activities.
- Periodically review and update the scope of collaboration to ensure its relevance.
- Use both Parties' logos in all collaborative events and materials.
- For the implementation of this FoU, the parties shall designate one nodal person each within one month of the commencement of this FoU to draw up the procedures, plan and strategy of recommended programmes of co-operation with a view to achieving the objective of the FoU.

3. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- The financial terms for specific training programs, research projects, or consulting assignments shall be agreed upon separately in writing before initiation.
- Neither Party shall incur financial obligations unless explicitly approved in writing by both Parties.

4. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- 4.1 Intellectual property (IP) created independently by either Party shall remain the property of that Party.
- 4.2 Jointly developed IP under this Agreement shall be co-owned by both Parties, with usage rights determined through mutual agreement.
- 4.3 SKIPA may utilize training materials provided by Indian Institute of Public Administration, New Delhi for its internal use, with proper acknowledgment and adherence to agreed terms.

5. TERM AND TERMINATION

- 5.1 This Agreement shall remain in effect for Five years from the Effective Date and may be renewed upon mutual written consent.
- 5.2 Either Party may terminate this Agreement by providing ninety (90) days' prior written notice to the other Party.

6. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither Party shall be held liable for delays or non-performance due to unforeseen events beyond their control, including natural disasters, pandemics, or government actions.

7. GOVERNANCE AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

This FoU is non-binding and non-exclusive, creating no legal obligation or liabilities for either Party. Disputes arising under this Agreement shall be resolved amicably through mutual discussions. Being Government organizations, the Parties are advised not to resort to arbitration or any other legal resources to resolve such disputes of differences.



8. EXECUTION AND DELIVERY

This Agreement is executed in duplicate, with each Party retaining one signed copy. Both Parties agree to the terms set forth herein.




