Subject: Tender Development of the Web Portal for M&E of Literacy and Legal Awareness (LLLA) Scheme

- IIPA floats tender for the selection of an agency to develop a web portal for monitoring and evaluation of the Legal Literacy and Legal Awareness (LLLA) scheme, sponsored by Department of Justice.
- The validity of the website will be for 24 months.
- The website would be dynamic in nature, where the monthly data will be uploaded and updated after verifying the data received from the implementation partners. An application of PHP / Drupal will be preferred.
- The website would be connected to the database. The data would be generated by the implementing agencies.
- There are six partners in the first year; however, the number would increase in the second year. The data would be converted to various graphical outputs, as selected by the users.
- The web portal would also require uploading the documents prepared by the different agencies along with photographs and the video.
- As the photographs and the videos are space consuming documents, this requires enough space on the server to host the website, which can be served by the independent host.
- The server needs to be secured as it would contain the sensitive data. No shared server will be allowed.
- An independent domain name is required to reflect the role of the Scheme (DISHA).
- The estimated traffic per year would be 200-300.
- Multiple infographics need to be prepared for the select data to produce a meaningful MIS monthly progress report, which needs to be submitted to the concerned ministry.
- The web portal would require a technical maintenance for two years, without any fail. Hence, presence of technical personnel is required for the continuous support.
- After two years, upon completion of the project (LLLA), the website is to be handed over to the ministry in a dynamic format, so that the same can be integrated with its website seamlessly.
